


Green Run to Cheney

- 5K is one loop around Cheney. Aid stations available. Flat, fast course.
- 1 mile course is one loop around city blocks.
- 6:00am 5K/1mi. Packet pick up / registration opens at Fairgrounds (you can sign up until right before race time)
- 6:00am 8mi. Packet pick up / registration opens at Garden Plain High School
- 6:30am 8 mile Start (Garden Plain)
- 7:30am 5K Start (Cheney Fairgrounds)
- 8:30am 1 mile Start

### Race History

The original Run to Cheney was held May 26, 1984 as part of the celebration for the city of Cheney's centennial. It was literally a run to Cheney, starting north of town on Lutheran Hill on Old Highway 54 (now W 15th St S) and finishing by the Citizens State Bank.

With increased participation, it wasn't feasible to keep the same route, so the race was moved to town and rescheduled to July to correspond with the Sedgwick County Fair, but the original name stuck. The race continued through 1993, 10 years in all, and drew quality competition.

The race returned in 2009 in time for Cheney's 125th birthday.

In 2015 we brought back the literal 8 run to Cheney starting at the Garden Plain track.
